We are writing to request your support for the annual "Friends of the Rangers" campaign. At the outset, contributions were used to reduce debt and pay for maintenance of the National Ranger Monument. In 2000, the Foundation retired its debt and established a scholarship program for Rangers, their spouses, their children and grandchildren. At the same time, a program to help Ranger families was developed in partnership with Family Readiness Groups of both the Ranger Training Brigade and the 75th Ranger Regiment.

The National Ranger Memorial Foundation has awarded almost \$300,000 in \$1,000 scholarships to deserving Rangers, their spouses, children and grandchildren. Additionally, the Foundation has provided more than \$10,500 to help Ranger families. These accomplishments were made possible by generous donors like you. All scholarships are in the form of a grant made directly to the school attended by the recipients ensuring funds can only be used toward tuition, books or other regulated fees. Help to Ranger families is determined by the commanders. Funds are provided through the Family Readiness Group.

A generous contribution of \$500 or more – all of which is tax deductible – will qualify you as a "Friend of the Rangers" for 2011. Your name, or the name you designate (wife, family member, combat buddy, etc.) will be engraved on a granite "Friends of the Rangers" ledger at the memorial.
